

**TITLE 25 - INDIANS**  
**CHAPTER 1 - BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS**

**§ 1. Commissioner of Indian Affairs**

There shall be in the Department of the Interior a Commissioner of Indian Affairs, who shall be appointed by the President, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate.
